Project Goals

BHHC will erect a sign at the entrance to the 26 acre preserve that protects habitat for the critically endangered Poweshiek skipperling butterfly. The sign will thank the donors, explain the preserve's importance, and set usage guidelines. A scenic overlook will be built at the crest for visitors and guided tours. Limited access parking will be created. Naming rights for the overlook are available.
